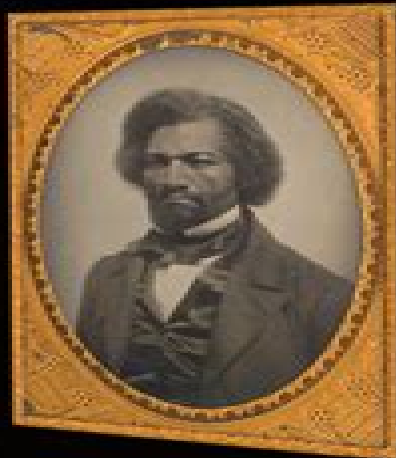

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stated nobody had more to fight for in the Civil War than black men Douglass continued his advocacy all the way until his death in 1895 Douglass was a firm believer in the equality of all people advocating on behalf of blacks women immigrants and even Native Americans Douglass famously said I would unite with anybody to do right and with nobody to do wrong Of all his speeches and writings his most famous are his autobiographies *Life and Times of Frederick Douglass (1892)* .
