Soekarno's duizend eilanden Carl Weiss, 1964 *Soekarno tabeh* Otto Kuijk, Bart van Veen, 1967 **Een leven in twee vaderlanden** Bert Scova Rhigini, 2022-01-10 Kort na haar terugkomst in Nederland als politiek vluchteling voor Soekarno s bewind typeert Beb Vuijk 1905 1991 haar leven als Avontuurlijker bewogener en opwindender dan van vele andere vrouwen niet in de eerste plaats door de uiterlijke omstandigheden en gebeurtenissen maar meer nog door de wijze hoe ik daarop reageerde fel hevig en totalitair omdat ik schrijfster ben en sterk en snel bewogen Deze biografie volgt nauwgezet en op de voet het boeiende leven van de op latere leeftijd vooral ook als kookboekenauteur bekend geworden schrijfster en hoe dit leven zijn neerslag vindt in haar literaire en journalistieke werk Voor de oorlog proberen Beb Vuijk en haar man zich een bestaan te verwerven met een kajoe poetihplantage op het nauwelijks door westerse invloeden beroerde eiland Boeroe in de Molukken na de oorlog zet zij zich als n van de weinige Nederlanders in voor een onafhankelijk Indonesi en volgt zij als Indonesisch staatsburger actief de ontwikkelingen in de nieuwe staat Terug in haar geboorteland komt haar leven weliswaar in rustiger vaarwater maar van een doorsnee bestaan is geen sprake niet in de laatste plaats door haar controversiële persoonlijkheid en opvattingen Ze schrijft dan haar beste literaire werk dat tegelijk een sfeervolle n indringende kroniek biedt van de laatste twee decennia Nederlandse aanwezigheid in de Oost 日本列島, 1973 日本列島 日本列島 (Japan), 1973 *Catalogus der Koloniale Bibliotheek van het Koninklijk Instituut voor de Taal-, Land- en Volkenkunde van Ned. Koloniale Bibliotheek, 1915 *National Union Catalog*, 1956 Includes entries for maps and atlases **Wisseling van de wacht** Henk Maier, 2025-02-10 De japanse bezetting van Indonesi 1942 1945 betekende een schokkende breuk met het Nederlandse koloniale bestuur De Nederlandse inwoners verdwenen al spoedig voor het overgrote deel in interneringskampen In Nederland is de Japanse bezetting dan ook vooral verbonden aan de internering waarover tientallen boeken zijn verschenen en nog verschijnen Aan Indonesische kant richt de aandacht zich vooral op wat er onmiddellijk op volgde de Revolutie die begon met het uitroepen van de onafhankelijkheid op 17 augustus 1945 De bevrijding van de eeuwenoude koloniale overheerser Nederland dat pas na bloedige strijd en onder druk van buitenlandse mogendheden en de publieke opinie overgng tot erkenning van de Republiek Indonesia vormt een hoogtepunt in de Indonesische geschiedenis dat de Japanse bezettingsjaren vrijwel geheel overschaduw Het lot van Indonesi en zijn bevolking onder de Japanse bezetting is daarom vrijwel onbekend maar niet minder beklagenswaardig Er was sprake van meedogenloze uitbuiting van land en volk in dienst van de Japanse oorlogsinspanning en een kwetsend en neerbuigend optreden De aanvankelijk hartelijke ontvangst van de Japanners als Aziatisch broedervolk als bevrijders sloeg dan ook snel om in onverschilligheid en zelfs actief verzet De tien in deze bundel opgenomen verhalen en fragmenten grotendeels voor het eerst uit het Indonesisch vertaald laten zien hoe Indonesi rs op de bezetter reageerden in literaire vorm met een vaak sterk

autobiografische inslag en als verslag en verantwoording van eigen daden Een in Nederland vrijwel onbekende geschiedenis krijgt zo vorm in bijvoorbeeld de aangrijpende verbeelding van Pramoedya Ananta Toer en Idrus en de herinneringen van Soekarno en Tan Malaka De samenstellers van deze bundel zijn Henk Maier hoogleraar Indonesisch aan de Rijksuniversiteit Leiden Don van Minde wetenschappelijk medewerker voor het Indonesisch aan de Leidse Universiteit en Harry Poeze hoofd van de KITLV Uitgeverij

Indië, betovering en desillusie Thom Hoffman, 2022-11-02 Thom Hoffman vindt een nieuwe vorm voor koloniale geschiedschrijving Kester Freriks NRC Razend interessant Wij sluiten het boek om het vervolgens weer te openen voor iedereen Omdat het belangrijk is Indië betovering en desillusie een persoonlijke zoektocht naar een verborgen geschiedenis die net iets minder verborgen is geworden dankzij Thom Hoffman Ruth Joos en Wilfried de Jong in Brommer op zee De liefde van de schrijver voor het land is ondanks de desillusie voelbaar in elk hoofdstuk Femke van der Laan in Nooit Meer Slapen Thom Hoffman heeft iets bijzonders gedaan Dertig jaar geleden kende hij dankzij zijn grootvader vooral de warme herinneringen aan de Indische sfeer en het lekkere eten Maar hij is veel over Nederlands Indië gaan lezen Subtiel ontvouwt hij de wrede kant van de geschiedenis Begeleid door prachtige illustraties oude affiches en foto's Mascha Sluijter Boekhandel Los in AD MEZZA Toch zijn het niet alleen maar losse stukjes zoals in een encyclopedie die hij ons voorschotelt Het is juist zijn persoonlijke zoektocht in de ondertitel die dit boek bijzonder maakt en die de losse delen aan elkaar verbindt Het zijn die delen in het boek waarin zijn persoonlijke betrokkenheid tot uiting komt en verklaren waarom hij dit allemaal doet Moesson Een compliment aan Thom Hoffman voor dit fabuleuze resultaat van een zoektocht die ooit begon met zijn spreekbeurt op de middelbare school in 1969 Azi Magazine Hoffmans jarenlange zoektocht naar het werkelijke Indië vanaf het begin van de VOC tot aan de onafhankelijkheid van Indonesië vindt zijn eindpunt in dit boek Boven mijn jongensbed hing een Sumatraanse tijger Zo begint Thom Hoffmans fascinerende en beeldende reis door de tijd Onder een imposante tijgerkop droomde hij als 13-jarige over het sepiagekleurde Nederlands Indië het land van zijn grootouders Oma en opa overleden kort na elkaar Hoe was hun leven in Indië geweest Omdat Thom zijn lievelingsoma geen vragen meer kon stellen ging hij op zoek naar antwoorden Geraakt door Couperus Multatuli Kousbroek Kartini Székely Lulofs en andere schrijvers en door films en documentaires maakte Hoffman de afgelopen dertig jaar een persoonlijke reis Hij begon met het verzamelen van boeken over Nederlands Indië en hoe meer hij las hoe duidelijker de contouren zich aftekenden van de kolonie onder Nederlands gezag van de VOC tot aan de soevereiniteitsoverdracht in 1949 Een geschiedenis die ver uitstijgt boven familieverledens Indië als decor voor betovering mysterie en schandaal maar ook het strijdtoneel voor opvattingen over verandering Het Indonesisch vrijheidsstreven leefde op Hoe ging Nederland daarmee om Boeiende persoonlijkheden als Jacob Haafner baron Van Hoëvell Kartini Tan Malaka Hatta en Soekarno completeren een caleidoscopisch en vaak aangrijpend beeld Indië betovering en desillusie is een boeiende en persoonlijke zoektocht naar de waarheid achter deze voormalige Nederlandse kolonie In de pers OVER THOM HOFFMAN Geef die man een filmprogramma Hoffman is een geboren verteller Het Parool OVER HOFFMANS
