Cognitive Neuroscience of Consciousness Anil Seth, Geraint Rees, 2013-05-13 How do conscious experience subjectivity and free will arise from the brain and the body Even in the late 20th century consciousness was considered to be beyond the reach of science Now understanding the neural mechanisms underlying consciousness is recognized as a key objective for 21st century science The cognitive neuroscience of consciousness is a fundamentally multidisciplinary enterprise involving powerful new combinations of functional brain imaging computational modelling theoretical innovation and basic neurobiology Its progress will be marked by new insights not only into the complex brain mechanisms underlying consciousness but also by novel clinical approaches to a wide range of neurological and psychiatric disorders These innovations are well represented by the contents of the present volume A target article by Victor Lamme puts forward the contentious position that neural evidence should trump evidence from behaviour and introspection in any theory of consciousness This article and its several commentaries advance one of the fundamental debates in consciousness science namely whether there exists non reportable phenomenal consciousness perhaps dependent on local rather than global neural processes Other articles explore the wider terrain of the new science of consciousness For example Maniscalco and colleagues use theta burst transcranial magnetic stimulation to selectively impair metacognitive awareness Massimini and coworkers examine changes in functional connectivity during anesthesia and Vanhaudenhuyse et al describe innovations in detecting residual awareness following traumatic brain injury Together then contents of this volume exemplify the grand challenge of consciousness in combining transformative questions about the human condition with a tractable programme of experimental and theoretical research

Mind as Machine Margaret A. Boden, 2006 Cognitive science is among the most fascinating intellectual achievements of the modern era The quest to understand the mind is an ancient one But modern science has offered new insights and techniques that have revolutionized this enquiry Oxford University Press now presents a masterly history of the field told by one of its most eminent practitioners Psychology is the thematic heart of cognitive science which aims to understand human and animal minds But its core theoretical ideas are drawn from cybernetics and artificial intelligence and many cognitive scientists try to build functioning models of how the mind works In that sense Margaret Boden suggests its key insight is that mind is a very special machine Because the mind has many different aspects the field is highly interdisciplinary It integrates psychology not only with cybernetics AI but also with neuroscience and clinical neurology with the philosophy of mind language and logic with linguistic work on grammar semantics and communication with anthropological studies of cultures and with biological and A Life research on animal behaviour evolution and life itself Each of these disciplines in its own way asks what the mind is what it does how it works how it develops and how it is even possible Boden traces the key questions back to Descartes s revolutionary writings and to the ideas of his followers and his radical critics through the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries Her story shows how controversies in the development of experimental physiology neurophysiology psychology evolutionary biology embryology and logic are still relevant today Then she guides the reader through the complex interlinked paths along which the study of mind developed in the twentieth century Cognitive science covers all mental phenomena not just cognition knowledge but also emotion personality psychopathology social communication religion motor action and consciousness In each area Boden introduces the key ideas and researchers and discusses those philosophical critics who see cognitive science as fundamentally misguided And she sketches the waves of resistance and acceptance on the part of the media and general public showing how these have affected the development of the field No one else could tell this story as Boden can she has been a member of the cognitive science community since the late 1950s and has known many of its key figures personally Her narrative is written in a lively swift moving style enriched by the personal touch of someone who knows the story at first hand Her history looks forward as well as back besides asking how state of the art research compares with the hopes of the early pioneers she identifies the most promising current work *Mind as Machine* will be a rich resource for anyone working on the mind in any academic discipline who wants to know how our understanding of mental capacities has advanced over the years

Jackendoff, 2009-01-23 An integrative approach to human cognition that encompasses the domains of language consciousness action social cognition and theory of mind that will foster cross disciplinary conversation among linguists philosophers psycholinguists neuroscientists cognitive anthropologists and evolutionary psychologists Ray Jackendoff's *Language Consciousness Culture* represents a breakthrough in developing an integrated theory of human cognition It will be of interest to a broad spectrum of cognitive scientists including linguists philosophers psycholinguists neuroscientists cognitive anthropologists and evolutionary psychologists Jackendoff argues that linguistics has become isolated from the other cognitive sciences at least partly because of the syntax based architecture assumed by mainstream generative grammar He proposes an alternative parallel architecture for the language faculty that permits a greater internal integration of the components of language and connects far more naturally to such larger issues in cognitive neuroscience as language processing the connection of language to vision and the evolution of language Extending this approach beyond the language capacity Jackendoff proposes sharper criteria for a satisfactory theory of consciousness examines the structure of complex everyday actions and investigates the concepts involved in an individual's grasp of society and culture Each of these domains is used to reflect back on the question of what is unique about human language and what follows from more general properties of the mind *Language Consciousness Culture* extends Jackendoff's pioneering theory of conceptual semantics to two of the most important domains of human thought social cognition and theory of mind Jackendoff's formal framework allows him to draw new connections among a large variety of literatures and to uncover new distinctions and generalizations not previously recognized The breadth of the approach will foster cross disciplinary conversation the vision is to develop a richer understanding of human nature

Consciousness as a Scientific Concept Elizabeth Irvine, 2012-10-13 The source of endless speculation and public curiosity our scientific quest for the origins of human consciousness has expanded along with the technical capabilities of science itself and remains one of the key topics able to fire public as much as academic interest Yet many problematic issues identified in this important new book remain unresolved Focusing on a series of methodological difficulties swirling around consciousness research the contributors to this volume suggest that consciousness is in fact not a wholly viable scientific concept Supporting this eliminativist stance are assessments of the current theories and methods of consciousness science in their own terms as well as applications of good scientific practice criteria from the philosophy of science For example the work identifies the central problem of the misuse of qualitative difference and dissociation paradigms often deployed to identify measures of consciousness It also examines the difficulties that attend the wide range of experimental protocols used to operationalise consciousness and the implications this has on the findings of integrative approaches across behavioural and neurophysiological research The work also explores the significant mismatch between the common intuitions about the content of consciousness that motivate much of the current science and the actual properties of the neural processes underlying sensory and cognitive phenomena Even as it makes the negative eliminativist case the

strong empirical grounding in this volume also allows positive characterisations to be made about the products of the current science of consciousness facilitating a re identification of target phenomena and valid research questions for the mind sciences
