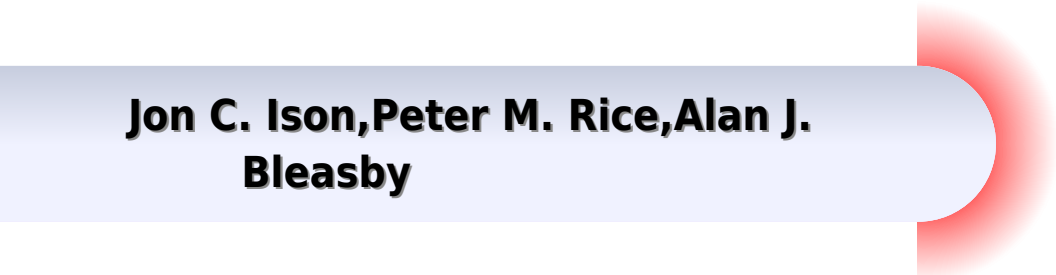


Technical Documentation: Essential Items to Include

ITEMS	DESCRIPTION
Source Control	Document where the source code is located and how to access it, including the platform or tool used for source control (such as GitHub, GitLab, BitBucket, or others).
Hosting	Document the process to deploy a new release of the product, including how much of the process is automated or manual, what steps and triggers are involved, how to debug a failed deployment, and how to roll back changes if necessary.
Development Environment Setup	Document how to set up a local copy of the application on a developer's computer, including what needs to be installed, where to find things, and how to build, test, and access the app locally.
