Write about 3 places you would like to travel someday. What do these three places have in common?

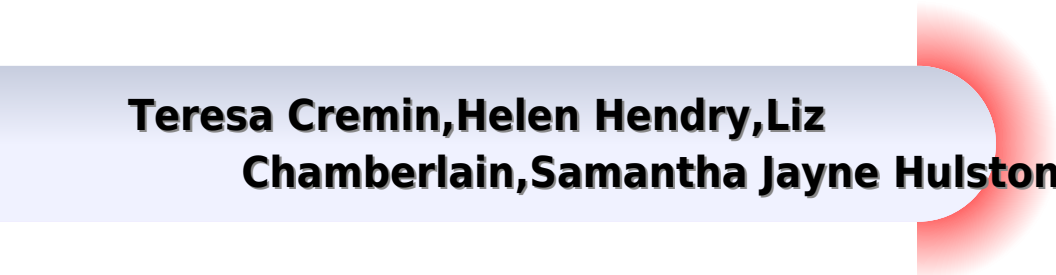
Write a poem that starts with the word "if".
