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The Open Society and Its Enemies Karl Popper, 2012-11-12 Popper is one of the twentieth century's towering and influential philosophical and intellectual figures widely read today. This marks the first time *The Open Society and Its Enemies* has been published in a single paperback volume; hardback version was published for the Popper Centenary in 2002. Features a preface by Vaclav Havel and a personal recollection on the story behind the book's publication by Ernst Gombrich. *The Open Society* is one of the twentieth century's most important books both in its impact on European intellectual and political life and in its sales.

The Accumulation of Capital Rosa Luxemburg, 2015-05-21 Rosa Luxemburg was a revolutionary socialist who fought and died for her beliefs. In January 1919, after being arrested for her involvement in a workers' uprising in Berlin, she was brutally murdered by a group of right-wing soldiers. Her body was recovered days later from a canal. Six years earlier, she had published what was undoubtedly her finest work.

The Law of Open Societies Jürgen Basedow, 2015-06-02 This book endeavours to interpret the development of private international law in light of social change. Since the end of World War II, the socio-economic reality of international relations has been characterised by a progressive move from closed to open societies. The dominant feature of our time is the opening of borders for individuals, goods, services, capital, and data. It is reflected in the growing importance of ex ante planning as compared with ex post adjudication of cross-border relations between individuals and companies. What has ensued is a shift in the forces that shape international relations from states to private actors. The book focuses on various forms of private ordering for economic and societal relations and its increasing significance while also analysing the role of the remaining regulatory powers of the states involved. These changes stand out more distinctly by virtue of the comparative treatment of the law and the long-term perspective employed by the author. The text is a revised and updated version of the lectures given by the author during the 2012 summer courses of the Hague Academy of International Law.

Michael Polanyi and His Generation Mary Jo Nye, 2011-09-16 In *Michael Polanyi and His Generation*, Mary Jo Nye investigates the role that Michael Polanyi and several of his contemporaries played in the emergence of the social turn in the philosophy of science. This turn involved seeing science as a socially based enterprise that does not rely on empiricism and reason alone but on social communities, behavioral norms, and personal commitments. Nye argues that the roots of the social turn are to be found in the scientific culture and political events of Europe in the 1930s, when scientific intellectuals struggled to defend the universal status of scientific knowledge and to justify public support for science in an era of economic catastrophe, Stalinism, and Fascism, and increased demands for applications of science to industry and social welfare. At the center of this struggle was Polanyi, who Nye contends was one of the first advocates of this new conception of science. Nye reconstructs Polanyi's scientific and political milieu in Budapest, Berlin, and Manchester from the 1910s to the 1950s and explains how he and other natural scientists and social scientists of his generation, including J. D. Bernal, Ludwik Fleck, Karl Mannheim, and Robert K. Merton, and the next such as Thomas Kuhn,

forged a politically charged philosophy of science one that newly emphasized the social construction of science

The Emergence of Post-modernity at the Intersection of Liberalism, Capitalism, and Secularism Matthew McManus, 2022-09-07 This book is a systematic and thorough analysis of what post modernity is and how it emerged It distinguishes between those who regard post modernity as a theoretical approach and those who regard it as a culture and argues that interpreting post modernity as a culture is more fruitful It discusses the three factors which led to its emergence namely liberalism capitalism and secularism highlighting their respective influence in generating the culture of post modernity within neoliberal societies The volume provides a lengthy analysis of neoliberal post modernity in practice arguing that post modernism is the cultural condition of neoliberal societies in the late 20th and early 21st centuries Until recently it seemed that neoliberal post modernity was here to stay framed by relationship to freedom and time which stressed individual agency but precluded the possibility of historical change at the political level However the Great Recession of 2008 opened new spaces for agitation and transformation which has resulted in the discordant politics of the last decade This book will be of interest to scholars working in a number of fields including economic policy cultural analysis political theory and social critique

How Not to be Governed Jimmy Casas Klausen, James R.
