Elements influencing believability of the study

The elements influencing believability can help the reader to focus on what to expect from a piece of presarch by asking questions regarding the researcher's academic and professional qualifications and the skills decoonstrated in presenting the study (Ryan-Wengez, 1992). These questions are similar to those asked when critiquing a quantitative study and were discussed in part 1 of this article (Conghlan et al. 2007). Questions relating to these elements are presented in Table 1.

Many of the topics examined in research studies are of an abstract nature in that the particular experience may be interpreted differently by another individual, or by the same individual under different circumstances, e.g. when in pains to qualitative research these abstract encounters or experiences are known as phenomena (Polis and Beck, 2006). At this stage the researcher should also justify the use of a qualitative approach and the qualitative methodology to be used (Connell Mechan, 1999).

Literature review

The function of a literature review in research studies is to provide an objective account of what has been written on a given subject. This in turn should reflect prominent emerging themes and inform the conceptual framework of the study.

Qualitative research follows the naturalistic panaligm based on the assumption that multiple realities exist and such scalities are constructed by the research participants. It aims to explore the phenomenon in question by focusing on the individuals who experience it (Vishnevsky and Beanlands, 2004).
