The Wizard of Mecosta: Russell Kirk, Gothic Fiction, and the Moral Imagination Camilo Peralta, 2024 The Wizard of Mecosta offers an extended analysis of the fiction of Russell Amos Kirk 1918-1994, a central figure in modern American conservatism who is often referred to as the father of the same. Born and raised in Michigan, Kirk was also a prolific writer of fiction who published almost two dozen short stories and three novels over the course of his long career. At the heart of everything Kirk wrote was what he referred to as the moral imagination, a phrase he borrowed from Edmund Burke and often used to describe the instructive and enlightening purposes of great literature. Despite his prominent reputation as a public man of letters and the respect of fellow authors including Ray Bradbury and Stephen King, Kirk's fiction was never very popular and has fallen into almost complete obscurity in the present. The Wizard of Mecosta is the first full-length study ever published about Kirk's fiction and the only work of any length to consider the entirety of his output, including all of the stories and novels he wrote. By emphasizing how Kirk's fiction illuminates certain aspects of his social and political theory, The Wizard of Mecosta distinguishes itself from the half-dozen or more studies of the author's life and work that have been published since his death in 1994. It should appeal to anyone with an interest in American conservatism as well as fans and scholars of the sort of Gothic horror in which Kirk unexpectedly excelled. Through his stories of avenging ghosts and timeless journeys through the afterlife, he reminds us of the existence of permanent things, the core values and beliefs of Western society which he strove all his life to preserve. It is high time that his fiction found a more appreciative and larger audience.

The Gothic Fiction of Adelaida García Morales Abigail Lee Six, 2006 By highlighting features common to the Gothic classics and the works of Adelaida García Morales this monograph aims to put the Gothic on the map in Hispanic Studies The Gothic as a literary mode extending well beyond its first proponents in eighteenth century England is well established in English studies but has been strangely under used by Hispanists Now Abigail Lee Six uses it as the paradigm through which to analyse the novels of Adelaida García Morales while not suggesting that every novel by this author is a classic Gothic text she reveals certain constants in the work that can be related to the Gothic even in novels which one might not classify as such Each of the novels studied is paired with an English language Gothic text such as Dracula Frankenstein and Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde and then read in the light of it The focus of each chapter ranges from psychological aspects such as fear of decay or otherness or the pressures linked to managing secrets to more concrete elements such as mountains and frightening buildings and to key figures such as vampires ghosts or monsters This approach sheds new light on how García Morales achieves probably the most distinguishing feature of her novels their harrowing atmosphere ABIGAIL LEE SIX is Professor of Hispanic Studies at Royal Holloway University of London
