Sugrue, 2008-11-04 The struggle for racial equality in the North has been a footnote in most books about civil rights in America Now this monumental new work from one of the most brilliant historians of his generation sets the record straight Sweet Land of Liberty is an epic revelatory account of the abiding quest for justice in states from Illinois to New York and of how the intense northern struggle differed from and was inspired by the fight down South Thomas Sugrue's panoramic view sweeps from the 1920s to the present more than eighty of the most decisive years in American history He uncovers the forgotten stories of battles to open up lunch counters beaches and movie theaters in the North the untold history of struggles against Jim Crow schools in northern towns the dramatic story of racial conflict in northern cities and suburbs and the long and tangled histories of integration and black power Appearing throughout these tumultuous tales of bigotry and resistance are the people who propelled progress such as Anna Arnold Hedgeman a dedicated churchwoman who in the 1930s became both a member of New York's black elite and an increasingly radical activist A Philip Randolph who as America teetered on the brink of World War II dared to threaten FDR with a march on Washington to protest discrimination and got the Fair Employment Practices Committee the second Emancipation Proclamation as a result Morris Milgram a white activist who built the Concord Park housing development the interracial answer to white Levittown and Herman Ferguson a mild mannered New York teacher whose protest of a Queens construction site led him to become a key player in the militant Malcolm X's movement Filled with unforgettable characters and riveting incidents and making use of information and accounts both public and private such as the writings of obscure African American journalists and the records of civil rights and black power groups Sweet Land of Liberty creates an indelible history Thomas Sugrue has written a narrative bound to become the standard source on this essential subject

original Lenape inhabitants to the myriad of residents in the twenty first century Philadelphia is famous for its colonial and revolutionary buildings and artifacts which draw tourists from far and wide to gain a better understanding of the nation s founding Philadelphians too value these same buildings and artifacts for the stories they tell about their city But Philadelphia existed long before the Liberty Bell was first rung and its history extends well beyond the American Revolution In Philadelphia A Narrative History Paul Kahan presents a comprehensive portrait of the city from the region s original Lenape inhabitants to the myriad of residents in the twenty first century As any history of Philadelphia should this book chronicles the people and places that make the city unique from Independence Hall to Eastern State Penitentiary Benjamin Franklin and Betsy Ross to Cecil B Moore and Cherelle Parker Kahan also shows us how Philadelphia has always been defined by ethnic religious and racial diversity from the seventeenth century when Dutch Swedes and Lenapes lived side by side along the Delaware to the nineteenth century when the city was home to a vibrant community of free Black and formerly enslaved people to the twentieth century when it attracted immigrants from around the world This diversity however often resulted in conflict especially over access to public spaces Those two themes diversity and conflict have shaped Philadelphia s development and remain visible in the city s culture society and even its geography Understanding Philadelphia s past Kahan says is key to envisioning future possibilities for the City of Brotherly Love

Hahn s book makes an important case for vigilance in the face of extremism and warns against telling the history of the United States as one of inevitable progress David Leonhardt New York Times Book Review If your reaction to the January 6 2021 insurrection at the Capitol was to think That s not us think again in Illiberal America a Pulitzer Prize winning historian uncovers a powerful illiberalism as deep seated in the American past as the founding ideals A storm of illiberalism building in the United States for years unleashed its destructive force in the Capitol insurrection of January 6 2021 The attack on American democracy and images of mob violence led many to recoil thinking That s not us But now we must think again for Steven Hahn shows in his startling new history that illiberalism has deep roots in our past To those who believe that the ideals announced in the Declaration of Independence set us apart as a nation Hahn shows that Americans have long been animated by competing values equally deep seated in which the illiberal will of the community overrides individual rights and often protects itself by excluding perceived threats whether on grounds of race religion gender economic status or ideology Driven by popular movements and implemented through courts and legislation illiberalism is part of the American bedrock The United States was born a republic of loosely connected states and localities that demanded control of their domestic institutions including slavery As white settlement expanded west and immigration exploded in eastern cities the democracy of the 1830s fueled expulsions of Blacks Native Americans Catholics Mormons and abolitionists After the Civil War southern states denied new constitutional guarantees of civil rights and enforced racial exclusions in everyday life Illiberalism was modernized during the Progressive movement through advocates of eugenics who aimed to reduce the numbers of racial and

ethnic minorities as well as the poor The turmoil of the 1960s enabled George Wallace to tap local fears of unrest and build support outside the South a politics adopted by Richard Nixon in 1968 Today with illiberalism shaping elections and policy debates over guns education and abortion it is urgent to understand its long history and how that history bears on the present crisis

Gang Nation Monica Brown, 2002 Explores how Latino gang culture mirrors the most destructive aspects of the American Dream through a look at novels and memoirs There s a place for us Somewhere a place for us With the emergence of a rich body of literature chronicling the experiences of Latino and Latina gang members popular understanding of this outlaw culture has advanced far beyond West Side Story However the diverse works discussed in this important book ranging from the breakthrough 1967 memoir *Down These Mean Streets* and the crime novel *Carlito s Way* to the play *Zoot Suit* and the World War II era historical novel *Don t Spit on My Corner* to more recent works such as *Always Running* *La Vida Loca* *Gang Days in L A* and Chicana gang narratives like *Locas* and *Two Badges* all share with the award winning musical a crucial discourse on nationality citizenship and belonging In *Gang Nation* Monica Brown offers a sophisticated analysis of these narratives produced by former gang members and by outside observers writing within the Latino community She examines the ubiquity of language and behavior within this literature that reveal the frustrated longings within gangs for greater participation in America s national culture and the desire of members to craft an alternative environment in which they are welcome Through literature and memoirs written from within the culture Brown illustrates how these youth mimic the rhetoric and rituals of American nationalism s most destructive aspects intense territoriality justification of violence and cultural chauvinism to assert their citizenship in an alternative nation Before now studies of gang culture have centered on either the choices of individual members or the social forces that inspire their unfocused rage But through Latino and Chicano gang literature Brown provides a more nuanced portrait of that culture one that raises broader concerns about dominant nationalism civil rights the criminalization of urban youth of color and the often unfulfilled sense of communal identity and acceptance among American youth

Hymnal Velma C. Williams, 1890 *The Makings and Unmakings of Americans* Cristina Stanciu, 2023-01-24 Challenges the myth of the United States as a nation of immigrants by bringing together two groups rarely read together Native Americans and Eastern European immigrants In this cultural history of Americanization during the Progressive Era Cristina Stanciu argues that new immigrants and Native Americans shaped the intellectual and cultural debates over inclusion and exclusion challenging ideas of national belonging citizenship and literary and cultural production Deeply grounded in a wide ranging archive of Indigenous and new immigrant writing and visual culture including congressional acts testimonies news reports cartoons poetry fiction and silent film this book brings together voices of Native and immigrant America Stanciu shows that although Native Americans and new immigrants faced different legal and cultural obstacles to citizenship the challenges they faced and their resistance to assimilation and Americanization often ran along parallel paths Both struggled against idealized models of American

citizenship that dominated public spaces Both participated in government sponsored Americanization efforts and worked to gain agency and sovereignty while negotiating naturalization Rethinking popular understandings of Americanization Stanciu argues that the new immigrants and Native Americans at the heart of this book expanded the narrow definitions of American identity Forging Rivals Reuel Schiller, 2015-03-23 Forging Rivals tells the story of the rise and fall of postwar liberalism vividly recounting the attempts of working people labor lawyers and civil rights litigators to create a legal system that promoted both economic opportunity and racial egalitarianism
