**Space and Time in Mediterranean Prehistory** Stella Souvatzi, Athena Hadji, 2013-10-15 Space and Time in Mediterranean Prehistory addresses these two concepts as interrelated rather than as separate categories and as a means for understanding past social relations at different scales The need for this volume was realised through four main observations the ever growing interest in space and spatiality across the social sciences the comparative theoretical and methodological neglect of time and temporality the lack in the existing literature of an explicit and balanced focus on both space and time and the large amount of new information coming from prehistoric Mediterranean It focuses on the active and interactive role of space and time in the production of any social environment drawing equally on contemporary theory and on case studies from Mediterranean prehistory Space and Time in Mediterranean Prehistory seeks to break down the space time continuum often assumed rather than inferred into space time units and to uncover the varying and variable interrelations of space and time in prehistoric societies across the Mediterranean The volume is a response to the dissatisfaction with traditional views of space and time in prehistory and revisits these concepts to develop a timely integrative conceptual and analytical framework for the study of space and time in archaeology **An island in Prehistory.**

**Neolithic and Bronze Ages finds from Kalymnos Dodecanese** Mario Benzi, 2020-11-20 The earliest prehistoric excavations on the island took place in 1887 when W R Paton discovered Mycenaean chamber tombs in the side of the torrent bed which runs into the harbour of Pothia to the east of the hill of Perakastro where the Late Bronze Age settlement stood Most of the vessels found from Paton were presented to the British Museum while others are preserved in other European Museums The first systematic excavations however took place only in the early twenties of the past century when the Italian archaeologist A Maiuri director of the archaeological exploration of the then Italian islands of the Dodecanese excavated the three prehistoric caves of Ayia Varvara 1920 Choiromandres 1921 and Vathy Dhaskalio 1922 which are the object of the present study **Ashlar** Maud Devolder, Igor Kreimerman, 2020-06-25 This volume focusses on ashlar masonry probably the most elaborate construction technique of the Eastern Mediterranean Bronze Age from a cross regional perspective The building practices and the uses of cutstone components and masonries in Egypt Syria the Aegean Anatolia Cyprus and the Levant in the 3rd and 2nd millennium BC are examined through a series of case studies and topical essays The topics addressed include the terminology of ashlar building components and the typologies of its masonries technical studies on the procurement dressing tool kits and construction techniques pertaining to cut stone investigations into the place of ashlar in inter regional exchanges and craft dissemination the extent and significance of the use of cut stone within the communities and regions and the visual effects social meanings and symbolic and ideological values of ashlar **Excavations at Tel**

**Kabri** Assaf Yasur-Landau, Eric H. Cline, 2020-06-08 Tel Kabri located in the western Galilee region of modern Israel several kilometers inland from modern Acco and Nahariyya was the center of a Canaanite polity during the Middle Bronze Age MB

Initial excavations conducted at the site from 1986 to 1993 revealed the remains of a palace dating primarily to the Middle Bronze Age II period during the first half of the second millennium BCE. Excavations were resumed at the site in 2005 under the co-direction of the present editors Assaf Yasur-Landau and Eric H. Cline. This volume presents the results of the work done at Tel Kabri from 2005 to 2011.

history e g the Roman empire known for their increased connectivity have thus been analyzed from a globalized perspective that examines rhizomal networking cultural diversity and multiple processes of social change Archaeology has proven a useful discipline for investigating ancient globalization because of its recent focus on how identity is expressed through material culture negotiated between both local and global influences when levels of connectivity are altered One form of identity that has been inadequately explored in relation to globalization theory is insularity Insularity or the socially recognized differences expressed by people living on islands is a form of self identification created within a particular space and time Insularity as a unique social identity affected by global forces should be viewed as an important research paradigm for archaeologies concerned with re examining cultural change The purpose of this volume is to explore how comparative archaeologies of insularity can contribute to discourse on ancient Mediterranean globalization The volume's theme stems from a colloquium session that was chaired by the volume's co editors at the Annual Meeting of the Archaeological Institute of America in January 2017 Given the current state of the field for globalization studies in Mediterranean archaeology this volume aims to bring together for the first time archaeologists working on different islands and a range of material culture types to examine diachronically how Mediterranean insularities changed during eras when connectivity increased such as the Late Bronze Age the era of Greek and Phoenician colonization the Classical period and during the High and Late Roman imperial eras Each chapter aims to situate a specific island or island group within the context of the globalizing forces and networks that conditioned a particular period and utilizes archaeological material to reveal how islanders shaped their insular identities or notions of insularity at the nexus of local and global influences
