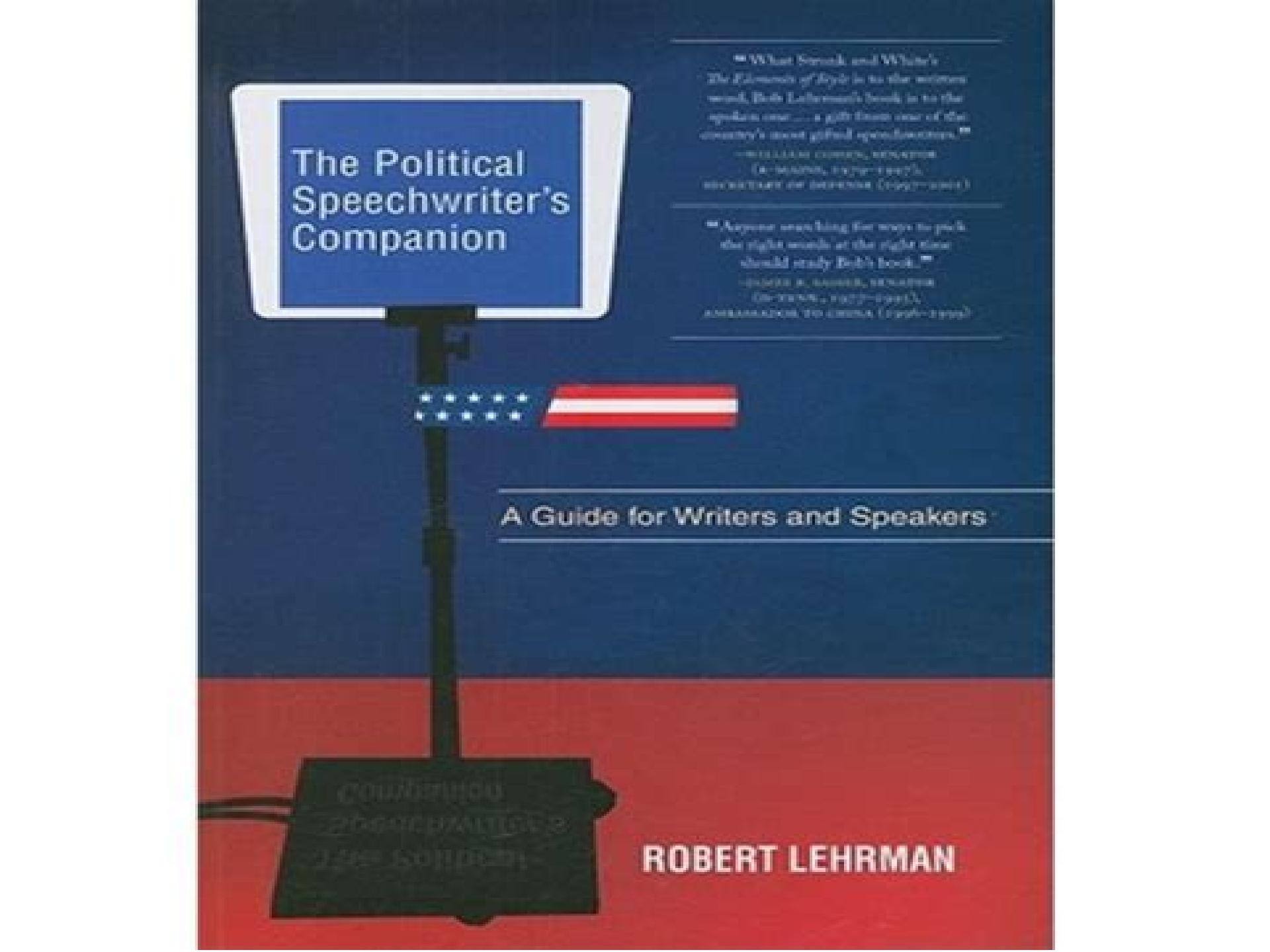

Bowers, 2003 Writing for the spoken word is a special discipline it requires that speechwriters products be written primarily although not exclusively to be heard not read Speeches are better cast in simple direct and often short sentences that can be easily understood by listeners Rhetorical devices such as repetition variation cadence and balance are available to and should be used by the speechwriter It is important for speechwriters to analyse audiences according to factors such as age gender culture profession and income level size of audience political affiliation if any and on the occasion for or purpose of the speech Most effective speeches do not exceed 20 minutes in length After researching a topic speechwriters must prepare an outline from which the speech will be developed They should strive to maintain a clear theme throughout the speech Most speeches will have a three part structure consisting of an introduction a body and a conclusion
