What is sociology? - Answer- Is one of the social sciences disciplines that examine the human or special world.

What is society? - Answer- A people who live in a defined geographic area who interact with one another and who share a common culture.

Be able to identify how each of these concepts could be used to explain a single social phenomenon. - Answer- This perspective is called a "realist" approach to social science. In contrast, "non-realist" approaches argue that one single concept (e.g., "Individualism or Naturalism") is both necessary and sufficient for explaining social phenomena.
Individuals, Nature, Culture, Agency, and Structure.

According to Peter Berger, what is the first wisdom of sociology? - Answer- . "NOTHING IS AS IT SEEMS TO BE"

What are the four dimensions of sociological consciousness (covered in the lecture slides)? - Answer- Debunking
Unrespectability
Relativizing
Cosmopolitanism

What is the difference between sociology and "common sense"? - Answer- Common sense views tend to reflect social traditions and conventions and therefore tend to reinforce the status quo and resist social change. Sociological views are based on rigorous research and therefore evidence based.

What is the sociological imagination? - Answer- Is a quality of the mind that allows us to understand the relationship between our particular situation in life and what is happening at a social level. "C. Wright Mills"

Differentiate between troubles vs. issues. - Answer- "Trouble" is less connected to solutions. It's more connected to negative feelings that you get when bad things happen. "Issue" is associated with difficult decisions and disagreements. We use "issue" in a similar way to "problem" or "trouble", but it also has another meaning.

Be able to distinguish between functionalist theory, conflict/critical theory, and symbolic interactionist theory. - Answer- Conflict Theory: Sees social conflict as the basis of society and social change. Society is a set of groups competing for power and resources.
