'My Mother was the Earth, My Father was the Sky' Nadia Majid, 2010 This study brings together three closely related aspects of Maori literature myth memory and identity It examines selected novels by Witi Ihimaera and Patricia Grace in order to trace an ever developing Maori identity that has changed considerably over three decades of the Maori novel This book demonstrates that an investigation of the construction of identity in literature benefits from a close look at the importance of Maori mythology as well as associated cultural and individual memories Indicating that Maori fiction has become what Homi Bhabha terms a third space this book verifies the links between novel myth and memory with the help of existing research in these areas in order to assess their importance for the reinterpretation of identity The Maori novels that depict situations reflecting current issues are viewed as an experimental playground in which authors can explore a variety of solutions to tribal societal and political issues This study establishes the early novels as reinterpretations of the past and guides to the future and characterises the more recent novels as representing a move towards empowerment and pioneering that has not yet come to a conclusion

The Science Fiction Dimensions of Salman Rushdie Yael Maurer, 2014-01-23 This book focuses on the science fictional dimensions of Rushdie's later novels *Fury* *The Ground Beneath Her Feet* *Shalimar the Clown* and *Luka and the Fire of Life* and Rushdie's first unpublished novel *The Antagonist* to show how the author's oeuvre moves towards a more consistent engagement with science fiction as a generic form and an ideological investment The author demonstrates how Rushdie recreates personal and national histories in a science fictional setting and mode and contends that the failure of his first novel *Grimus* may have led Rushdie away from SF for some time although he returns to it with a much firmer conviction and a much stronger voice in his later novels showing his commitment to this imaginative form which he describes in *Fury* as providing the best popular vehicle ever devised for the novel of ideas and metaphysics The science fictional mode is the most appropriate vehicle for expressing these thematic and ideological concerns and the organizing feature of Rushdie's oeuvre The author rereads the later novels in light of recent critical engagement with SF as a vehicle for reimagining national histories and as a potentially subversive tool for social and political engagement in a fictional realm

Performance and Performativity in Contemporary Indian Fiction in English Maria-Sabina Draga Alexandru, 2015-02-04 This book starts with a consideration of a 1997 issue of the *New Yorker* that celebrated fifty years of Indian independence and goes on to explore the development of a pattern of performance and performativity in contemporary Indian fiction in English Salman Rushdie Arundhati Roy and Vikram Chandra Such fiction which constructs identity through performative acts is built around a nomadic understanding of the self and implies an evolution of narrative language towards performativity whereby the text itself becomes nomadic A comparison with theatrical performance Peter Brook's *Mahabharata* and Girish Karnad's theatre of roots serves to support the argument that in both theatre and fiction the concepts of performance and performativity transform classical Indian mythic poetics In the mythic symbiosis of performance and storytelling in Indian tradition within a cyclical pattern of estrangement from and return to the motherland and/or its traditions myth becomes a liberating space of consciousness where rigid categories and boundaries are transcended
