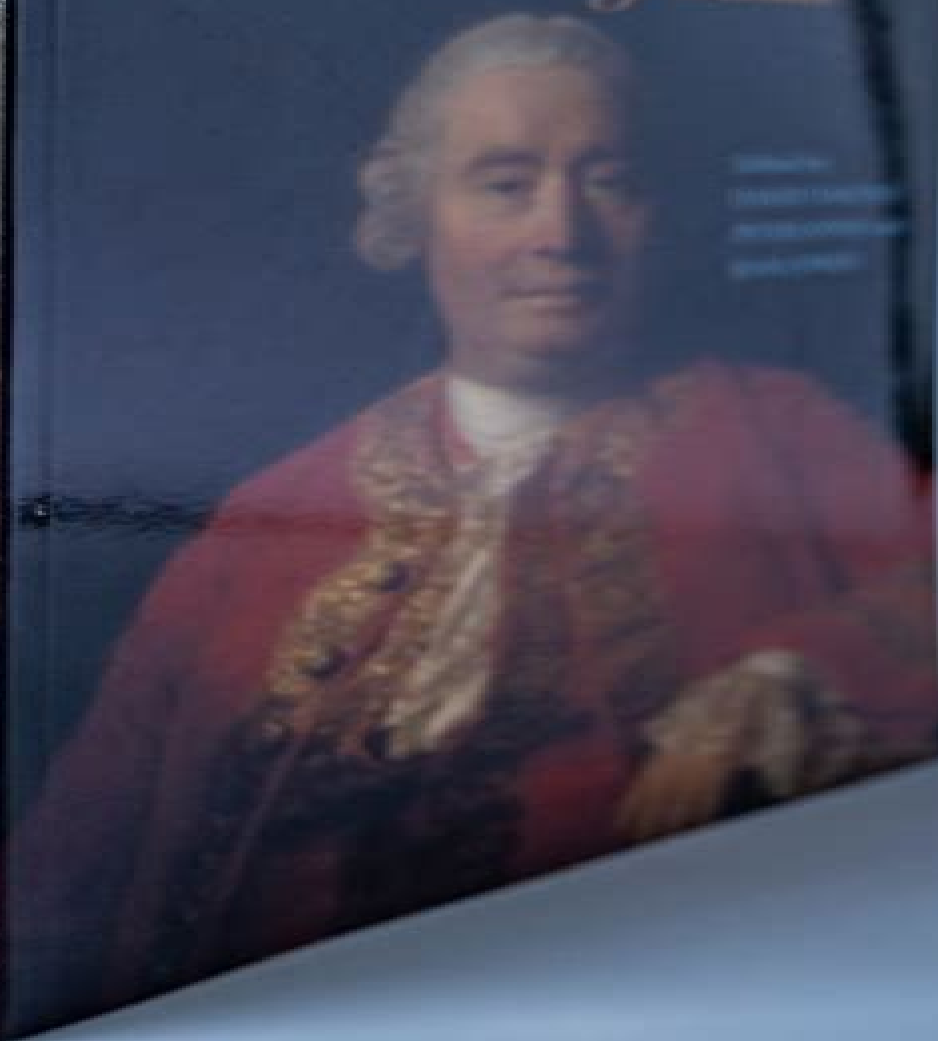

Nineteenth-century Scottish Rhetoric Winifred Bryan Horner, 1993 Winifred Bryan Horner argues that an understanding of the changes that occurred in the content of nineteenth century courses in logic rhetoric and belles lettres taught in Scottish universities provides important critical insight into the development of the twentieth century American composition course as well as courses in English literature and critical theory Because of the inaccessibility of primary materials documenting the changes in courses taught at Scottish universities the impression remains that the nineteenth century represents a break with the traditional school curriculum rather than a logical transition to a new focus of study Horner has discovered that the notes of students who attended these classes meticulously transcribed records of the lectures that professors dictated in lieu of printed texts provide reliable documentation of the content of courses taught during the period Using these records Horner traces the evolution of current traditional composition developed in the United States in the first part of the twentieth century from courses taught in nineteenth century northern Scottish universities She locates the beginning of courses in English literature and belletristic composition in the southern schools particularly Edinburgh Horner's study opens new vistas for the study of the evolution of university curricula especially the never before acknowledged influence of belletristic rhetoric on the development of the North American composition course **Human Rights and**

The Masochistic Pleasures of Sentimental Literature Marianne Noble,2000-04-04 For generations critics have noticed in nineteenth century American women s sentimentality a streak of masochism but their discussions of it have over simplified its complex relationship to women s power Marianne Noble argues that tropes of eroticized domination in sentimental literature must be recognized for what they were a double edged sword of both oppression and empowerment She begins by exploring the cultural forces that came together to create this ideology of desire particularly Protestant discourses relating suffering to love and middle class discourses of true womanhood She goes on to demonstrate how sentimental literature takes advantage of the expressive power in the convergence of these two discourses to imagine women s romantic desire Therefore in sentimental literature images of eroticized domination are not antithetical to female pleasure but rather can be constitutive of it The book however does not simply celebrate that fact In readings of Warner s *The Wide Wide World* Stowe s *Uncle Tom s Cabin* and Dickinson s sentimental poetry it addresses the complex benefits and costs of nineteenth century women s literary masochism Ultimately it shows how these authors both exploited and were shaped by this discursive practice *The Masochistic Pleasures of Sentimental Literature* exemplifies new trends in Third Wave feminist scholarship presenting cultural and historical research informed by clear lucid discussions of psychoanalytic and literary theory It demonstrates that contemporary theories of masochism including those of Deleuze Bataille Kristeva Benjamin Bersani Noyes Mansfield are more relevant and comprehensible when considered in relation to sentimental literature

The Celtic Unconscious offers a vital new interpretation of modernist literature through an examination of James Joyce's employment of Scottish literature and philosophy as well as a commentary on his portrayal of shared Irish and Scottish histories and cultures Barlow also offers an innovative look at the strong influences that Joyce's predecessors had on his work including James Macpherson James Hogg David Hume Robert Burns and Robert Louis Stevenson The book draws upon all of Joyce's major texts but focuses mainly on *Finnegans Wake* in making three main interrelated arguments that Joyce applies what he sees as a specifically Celtic viewpoint to create the atmosphere of instability and skepticism of *Finnegans Wake* that this reasoning is divided into contrasting elements which reflect the deep religious and national divide of post 1922 Ireland but which have their basis in Scottish literature and finally that despite the illustration of the contrasts and divisions of Scottish and Irish history Scottish literature and philosophy are commissioned by Joyce as part of a program of artistic decolonization which is enacted in *Finnegans Wake* The Celtic Unconscious is the first book length study of the role of Scottish literature in Joyce's work and is a vital contribution to the fields of Irish and Scottish studies This book will appeal to scholars and students of Joyce and to students interested in Irish studies Scottish studies and English literature

Where Peter Newman's best selling trilogy captured the essence of the Hudson's Bay Company HBC as a business empire Eighteenth Century Naturalists of Hudson Bay presents the scientific achievements of the company's early employees drawing largely on materials in the HBC Winnipeg archives C Stuart Houston Tim Ball and Mary Houston make amends for two centuries of neglect of these collector observers showing that fur traders in isolated trading posts on Hudson Bay were involved in some of the earliest stirrings of science on the continent and that the fur traders and Native people worked together in a remarkable symbiosis beneficial to both parties The authors show that meteorologic data and weather information recorded at the HBC trading posts over two centuries provide the largest and longest consecutive series available anywhere in North America one that can help us understand the mechanisms and amount of climate change They demonstrate that Hudson Bay is the second largest site of new bird species named by Linnaeus and reproduce some of George Edwards' colour paintings of these new species Six informative appendices reveal how the invaluable HBC archives were transferred from London England to Winnipeg correct previous misinterpretations of the collaboration and relative contributions of Thomas Hutchins and Andrew Graham use two centuries of HBC fur returns to demonstrate the ten year hare and lynx cycles tell how the swan trade almost extirpated the Trumpeter Swan explain how the Canada Goose got its name before there was a Canada and offer an extensive list of eighteenth century Cree names for birds mammals and fish Informative tables list the eighteenth century surgeons at York Factory and give names and dates for the annual supply ships
