A frame structure is usually made from a combination of beams, columns, and walls. If used in the right way, our shapes can be strong shapes in framework structures.



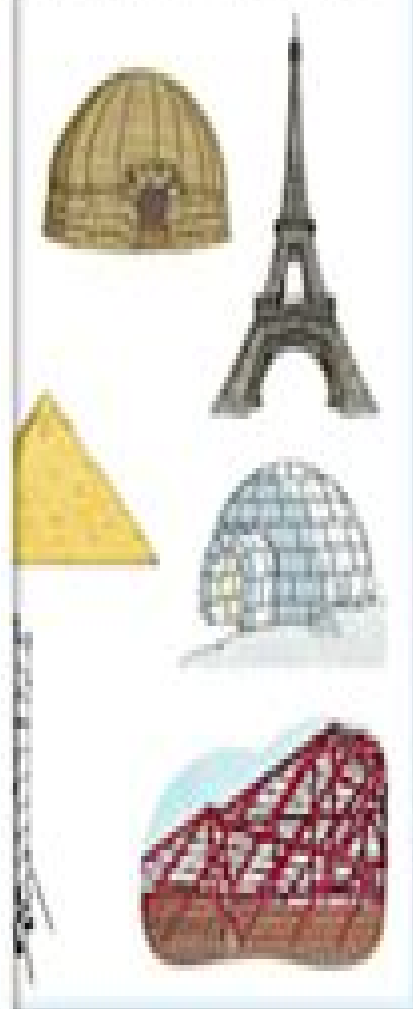
