Slow Democracy Susan Clark, Woden Teachout, 2012 Reconnecting with the sources of decisions that affect us and with the processes of democracy itself is at the heart of 21st century sustainable communities Slow Democracy chronicles the ways in which ordinary people have mobilized to find local solutions to local problems It invites us to bring the advantages of slow to our community decision making Just as slow food encourages chefs and eaters to become more intimately involved with the production of local food slow democracy encourages us to govern ourselves locally with processes that are inclusive deliberative and citizen powered Susan Clark and Woden Teachout outline the qualities of real local decision making and show us the range of ways that communities are breathing new life into participatory democracy around the country We meet residents who seize back control of their municipal water systems from global corporations parents who find unique solutions to seemingly divisive school redistricting issues and a host of other citizens across the nation who have designed local decision making systems to solve the problems unique to their area in ways that work best for their communities Though rooted in the direct participation that defined our nation's early days slow democracy is not a romantic vision for reigniting the ways of old Rather the strategies outlined here are uniquely suited to 21st century technologies and culture If our future holds an increased focus on local food local energy and local economy then surely we will need to improve our skills at local governance as well

and others at the top of the wealth ladder Stories told along the way explore the roots of advantage show how taxpayers subsidize the wealthy and reveal how charity used incorrectly can actually reinforce extreme inequality Readers meet pioneers who are crossing the divide to work together in new ways including residents in the author's own Boston area neighborhood who have launched some of the most interesting community transition efforts in the nation In the end Collins's national and local solutions not only challenge inequality but also respond to climate change and offer an unexpected fresh take on one of our most intransigent problems

Drawing on the tools of game design to fix democracy Anyone who has ever been to a public hearing or community meeting would agree that participatory democracy can be boring Hours of repetitive presentations alternately alarmist or complacent for or against accompanied by constant heckling often with no clear outcome or decision Is this the best democracy can offer In Making Democracy Fun Josh Lerner offers a novel solution for the sad state of our deliberative democracy the power of good game design What if public meetings featured competition and collaboration such as team challenges clear rules presented and modeled in multiple ways measurable progress such as scores and levels and engaging sounds and visuals These game mechanics would make meetings more effective and more enjoyable even fun Lerner reports that institutions as diverse as the United Nations the U S Army and grassroots community groups are already using games and game like processes to encourage participation Drawing on more than a decade of practical experience and extensive research he explains how games have been integrated into a variety of public programs in North and South America He offers rich stories of game techniques in action in children's councils social service programs and participatory budgeting and planning With these real world examples in mind Lerner describes five kinds of games and twenty six game mechanics that are especially relevant for democracy He finds that when governments and organizations use games and design their programs to be more like games public participation becomes more attractive effective and transparent Game design can make democracy fun and make it work
